'If in doubt, report it'

If you have a safeguarding concern you **MUST** report it. Everyone has a responsibility to report any concern they may have regarding the welfare of a young person or adult at risk within rounders, particularly when it comes to protecting them from abuse.

SERIOUS CONCERNS / IMMINENT RISK

- If you believe a child or adult at risk is in immediate danger, call the police or Children/Adult Services in your local area.
