

The closing date for receipt of all entries is midnight on Midnight 3rd July 2020

- No entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the competition.
- 2. This competition is open to any secondary or primary school in the UK.
- 3. By entering the competition, schools accept these terms and conditions.
- 4. Each pupil must enter a bat design and a poster explaining Top Rounders Warm up/Exercise to do from home. Submission of only one of these will result in disqualification from the competition.
- No responsibility can be accepted for lost, delayed, damaged or incomplete entries. Proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery. The closing date for receipt of all entries is midnight on 3rd July 2020.
- 6. Each entrant warrants to Aresson that the pupil's entry is the pupil's own work.
- Entries will not be returned to entrants and Aresson accepts no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, any designs.
- 8. All correctly completed, full entries (bat design and advert) will be reviewed and considered.
- 9. The winning design in each category will be recreated as closely as possible on an Aresson presentation bat and awarded to the winning pupil who created the design. The bats will be awarded prior to the start of 2021 outdoor rounders season.
- Every school that submits entries will automatically be entered into a prize draw to receive an Aresson rounders set (excluding the club set).
- 11. The winning pupils will be informed during the week commencing 6th July 2020 via the contact details listed on your entry. The winning school from the prize draw will also be contacted during the week commencing 6th July 2020. Prizes will be sent thereafter.

- 12. Where possible some designs will be shared via social media prior to the close of the competition. This will be done anonymously.
- 13. Events may occur that render the design competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond Aresson's control. Aresson may, at its absolute discretion, vary or amend the competition and the winners agree that, in such event, no liability shall attach itself to Aresson, provided that any prize shall not be of lesser value than the one advertised.
- 14. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15. The winners agree to take part in reasonable postevent publicity and to the use of their names and photographs in such publicity.
- 16. All entrants hereby license to Aresson the use of their entry for display on any Aresson owned website and physical banners and for display in an exhibition.
